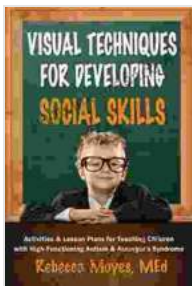

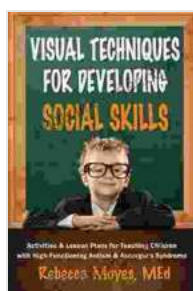

English	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Consider a reader/writer for class assessments. Introduce "break" cards for when the class environment becomes overwhelming. Provide William worksheets and sheets to help Sam revise content in his own time. Sam will take photos of the whiteboard at the end of the lesson.
Maths	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sam would like to be able to bring the class text book home as this is favorite subject. He understands this is against school policy. Sam's parents will purchase a copy for home (teacher to send link).
Social Studies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Consider a reader/writer for class assessments. Let Sam keep the same desk when seating plan changes.
Physical Education	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Prepare Sam for group sports by telling him in advance. Introduce "Break" cards for when the class environment becomes overwhelming. Teacher will be mindful of the peers he places Sam with for group work.
Health	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sam will participate in the junior social skills group.
Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Allow Sam to wear earplugs if class becomes too noisy. Sam feels the pace of the class is too fast and he can't keep up. Teacher will create printouts for each lesson to support Sam's learning.
Sports Science	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Consider a reader/writer for class assessments.
Home Technology	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sam will work on his toy project at lunch times so that there's less noise.
Key Competencies and Communication	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Create a buddy system and accompanying roster to support Sam's transitions from class to class. Communication cards will be used in class by Sam.
Therapy Support <u>Occupational Therapy</u> OT will consult with SENCO to support physical education and health goals.	
<u>Speech Language Therapy</u> SLT will liaise with family, audiology services and MOE to apply for a microphone and recording system for teachers to wear.	



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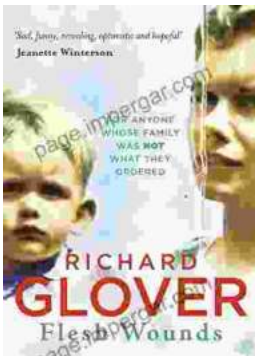
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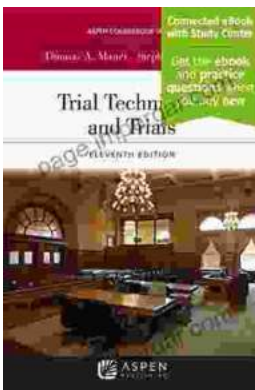
