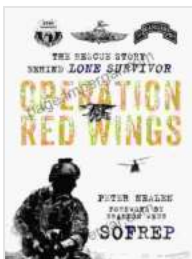


Lone Survivor: The Inside Story of the Harrowing Rescue Mission that Changed the Course of the War in Afghanistan

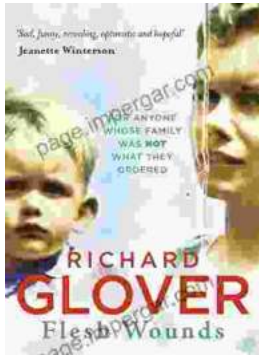


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
